Often experience of deprivations in life teaches us many lessons. When deprivation becomes a system, helplessness becomes a way of life. Finding no way to get out of the suffocating experience, the human person resigns to the reality as his or her fate. That is exactly what happens to a person affected with leprosy. 47 years ago, Servant of God Marian Zelazek, SVD appeared as a beacon of light to the 600 odd leprosy victims living on the outskirts of Puri city. In him they saw a person who accepted and respected them as human beings, rather than beggars to be shooed away. That encounter eventually grew into *Karunalaya Leprosy Care Centre*. Karunalaya continues its relentless service of compassion to the residents of Jeebaramji Leprosy Colony, lending an attentive ear to their cries of pain, extending a trusting hand of friendship and a shoulder to lean on. Christmas reminds us that we are called to emulate these core



values of compassionate love as we celebrate the birth of a person who changed the face of the earth by his compassion and love. A walk with 'Karunalaya' will confirm that this commitment to these vulnerable people continues unabated.



END OF A MOMENTOUS ERA

DR. SHYAM BANDHU MAHAPATRA is a legend in Leprosy treatment and rehabilitation in Odisha. He has single handedly changed the way leprosy is perceived and treated, through innovative methods and family based rehabilitation approach that he promoted during his long tenure as a Super Specialist in the field. Upon his retirement from active service, he honoured the earnest request of Father Marian and joined hands with Karunalaya to share his passion and expertise. During this period of his association, the Hospital care at Karunalaya was standardized, irregularities and indiscipline was set right. His in-depth knowledge of the disease, intuition and compassionate touch healed hundreds of victims. His personal touch endeared him to each and every patient visiting him over the years. His passion and dedication to the welfare of the victims of leprosy was indomitable. With a heavy heart, Dr. Mahapatra bid us farewell in the beginning of August, 2022, as he left Puri for good after rendering a yeoman service to leprosy care and rehabilitation for over 50 years. The patients whom he served for these long years were inconsolable. Karunalaya was fortunate to have the services of this illustrious and eminent Doctor for 20 plus years. The void created by his departure at *Karunalaya* can never be filled.

DOCTOR WITH A HUMAN TOUCH

Blessings of Father Marian have been guiding the pathway of *Karunalaya* over the years. Yet another example of this is finding another eminent Doctor to replace Dr. S.B. Mahapatra at *Karunalaya*. DR. BASANTA KUMAR MISHRA, (Rt.) Chief Medical Officer, Coal India, (Maha Ratna PSE, Govt. of India), has joined as Medical Officer at *Karunalaya* in the month of October, 2022. He brings with him immense administrative experience in one of the large medical establishment in the country. He is a medicine specialist. His personal touch has made a huge impression on the leprosy patients visiting the bi-weekly clinic in a short time.

The hospital attended to 2200 OPD cases and had 75 admissions during the year for intense care. The daily dressings of ulcer wounds numbered 4480. These essential cares are a vital contribution to the wellbeing of about 120 elderly victims of leprosy living in the colony. The average expenditure for Medicine purchase for one month amounts to Rs.22,000.00. These are dispensed to the patients at the



bi-weekly clinic at the hospital on Doctor's advise, without any cost. "But for the generous medical care received from Karunalya, most of the older victims would have gone to Swarga Dwar (crematorium) long ago," exclaim some of the grateful victims.



HEALING MISSION

"Karuanalya Cottage of Mercy & Compassion" is the name of our medical facility in the middle of the leprosy colony. 75 persons used the short stay facility and its services to get relief and healing from their ailments. The bi-weekly clinic saw 2200 patients in its OPD and 4480 ulcer dressings were administered to the victims during the year.

MERCY KITCHEN

The nurturing mother 'MERCY KITCHEN' continues feeding the 30 destitute and elderly persons in the leprosy colony every day of the year. Number of local donors have come forward to patronize one meal during the day, on special occasions or observations in their families. Coming to share food with these less fortunate ones has been a life changing experience for some of them.

BEATRIX SCHOOL

After the lull of the pandemic, life is back to normal at Beatrix School. Children are once again enjoying life with friends and teachers. Class rooms are full with children, each class having 65 & above on the roll. The time during the closure of the school due to Covid-19 was utilized for the necessary repairs

and painting of the School building. The school looks majestic with the much-needed refurbishment of the class rooms and the exterior.

Beatrix School has 7 approved Grant-in-Aid posts in the primary & upper primary sections. Of these 4 posts are vacant at present due to retirement of teachers. The newly appointed teachers, following the prescribed procedure as given in 'The Odisha Education (Minority



Managed Aided Educational Institutions Employees' Method of Recruitment & Conditions of Service) Order 2003, are in various stages of approval. Beatrix High School attained eligibility for grant in aid in 2020 and the application for Grant in aid is pending at the Government level. An early clearance of these will greatly ease the financial burden of managing the school.

PROUD MOMENT FOR THE SCHOOL

Abhilipsa Rout & Urmila Rout both hailing from the leprosy colony promoted by Father Marian were the school toppers with 94% & 92% marks respectively in the annual matriculation exam held in March, 2022. Both these bright children shining out in the midst of deprivations they have been facing, has been a proud moment for the School. While Abhilipsa wants to be a medical doctor and has taken admission in a Science residential College in Bhubaneswar, Urmila is aspiring to be an Indian Administrative Officer. *Karunalaya* has promised to support both of them in achieving their dreams.

HOME WITH A DIFFERENCE BEATRIX HOSTEL

Leprosy colonies are generally situated on the outskirts of city dwellings. When parents go begging to earn their living, children from these colonies waste their childhood in idling around. The luckier ones among them have joined Beatrix School for studies and live in the Hostel attached to the school. This is their home away from home where they are loved and




cared for tenderly with affection. They are assisted to get over their inhibitions and inferiority thrust on them by the stigma attached to the illness of their parents or grandparents. 35 of these children are enjoying their childhood with good foundation for their future in Beatrix School.
